POSITION DETAILS:

- Implement appropriate teaching strategies as prescribed by the students' individualized education plan.
- Implement appropriate behavior management techniques, including any crisis management procedures, as outlined in the student's behavior intervention plan.
- Follow reinforcement schedules and use reinforcement appropriately.
- Complete data collection as directed by supervising BCBA.
- Communicate both orally and written with supervisor and colleagues.
- Work with school personnel to ensure effective ongoing implementation of behavioral strategies for student success.

- Must hold valid Indiana Driver's License and be able to travel between buildings.
- Must possess the RBT credential and be in good standing with the BACB.
