QUALIFICATIONS:

- Candidates must possess a current Indiana teaching license and be highly qualified.
- UFLI experience preferred
- Experience with ESL/ENL instruction, reading intervention, intervention planning, progress monitoring, and reading diagnosis is required.
- As required by the State of Indiana, lead teachers of students currently in grades 2 and 3 must have completed at least 25 hours from the Early Literacy Endorsement Verified Professional Development Programs (Keys to Literacy hours count) and be working toward earning the Early Literacy Endorsement if required for their license renewal after June 30, 2027.
- Note: Other than emergency absences, it will be expected that teachers will be present at each training and instructional day.
